The community centre is used three days a week as a warm hub, as well as the bar area being used by other regular hirers. The kitchen does not currently have a fridge.

A fridge has been purchased for the warm hub and groups to use costing £166.

There is currently £1,360 left in the capital expenditure budget and a further £339 from the sale of unused equipment (as of end 23-11).

It is proposed capital expenditure funds are used for the purchase.
