REPORT

The council agreed its fees and charges for 2024/25 at the March Full Council meeting.

This included fees for the changing room hire for the 2024/25 season and split out the toilets from use of all facilities:

CHANGING FACILITY HIRE - SAXILBY RECREATION GROUND	
SEASON CHARGE	
Toilets only	£ 180.00
All facilities - home and away changing and shower rooms, refs room, and toilets	£ 240.00
ONE-OFF HIRE CHARGE (per session)	
Toilets only	£ 11.00
All facilities - home and away changing and shower rooms, refs room, and toilets	£ 18.00

The bowls club have since been in touch to request a “six-month block booking of the toilet facilities only. As the bowls Season is only from the 1st April till 30th September for the hire of the toilet facilities only at the centre.”

Council is requested to clarify whether the toilet season charge stands at £180 or whether it is reduced on the basis of the bowls club contact.
