



Saxilby Waterfront Working Group

Update for Planning and Development Committee

Wednesday 15 May 2024

1. Queensway bus shelter (master plan 6.1) With the drier weather someone is coming out from the bus shelter company to take out the panels, dry them, to re-install and reseal.

2. Events 2024:

- i. Formal opening of the footbridge was a success.
- ii. LDAA Fishing event will be held Saturday 20th July
- iii. The music event for September is Sunday 15th September.

3. Artwork (master plan 6.8) LCC have refused the license request to put the shoal of fish on the footbridge ramp. A site meeting is being arranged to discuss it further or find another possible site. The intergenerational work to design the fish will start in June after half term.

4. Replacement dog bin: A new black dog bin is proposed to replace the rusty dog bin across the footbridge.

5. Public Toilets (master plan 6.7) Funding applications for the public toilet refurbishment are in the process of being completed. We are in the process of applying for Tesco Stay Stronger grant and the Community Lottery.

6. Highway and Traffic concerns (masterplan 3)

- a) Concerns have been raised by local residents that mobility scooters are unable to use the footpath due vehicles parking. SWWG recommendation is for double yellow lines for the corner of Bridge Place.
- b) Concerns were raised about parking on Bridge Street and a recommendation is a request for Highways to have a site visit from Canal Court to Queensway.

7. Benches (masterplan 6.14) To accept the offer of a 'salmon' fishing bench and base by LDAA and a 'robin' bench with a plaque donated by a local family. Both benches to be sited on the top towpath.

8. Mosaic(masterplan 6.4)

Due to advice from the original mosaic artists that the flood wall is not suitable to put the mosaic on, alternative sites have been sourced. The Co-op have asked for more information regarding the mosaic in response from a request to consider siting it outside the pharmacy.

Recommendations:

To receive an update and agree the above recommendations for 4,5,6,7,8:

4. Purchase a replacement black dog bin
5. Apply for Tesco Stay Stronger grant and set up Community Lottery
- 6a. Request double yellow lines for the corner of Bridge Place from Highways
- 6b. Request for Highways to have a site visit from Canal Court
7. Accept the offer of a 'salmon' fishing bench and base by LDAA and a 'robin' bench with a plaque donated by a local family. Both benches to be sited on the top towpath and officers to liaise with CRT to progress
8. Liaise with the Co-op regarding siting the mosaic there
