One elderly gentleman has already slipped on the ice and broken his hip. Also the corner of William st/One Stop shop is uneven slopy ground and treacherous when icy.

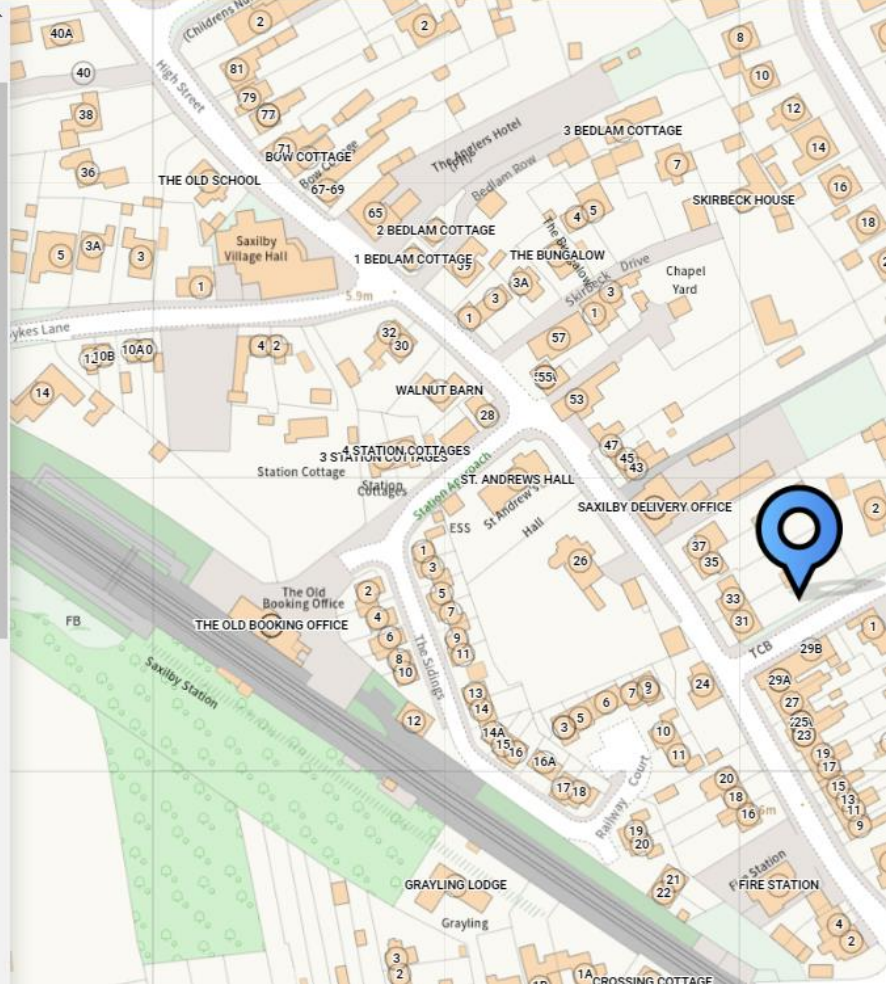
