REPORT:

A request has been received for a bus shelter to be erected on the Gainsborough route. The current bus shelters provide cover for stops heading in the Lincoln direction.

The next bus stop identified in the Neighbourhood Development Plan for a shelter is opposite the Co-op (see below). This is on the Gainsborough route.

RECOMMENDATION(S):

It is proposed that planning and development committee recommend to full council to

- 1) Seek to install a bus shelter at the bus stop opposite the Co-op (three bay, black cantilever, ½ side panel, and perch seat)
- 2) Clerk to obtain costings
- 3) Make an application to Lincolnshire county council to
 - a. For permission to install a bus shelter
 - b. Apply for a bus shelter grant
- 4) Identify funds if there is a shortfall e.g. capital expenditure/planning contributions
- 5) Notify nearest neighbours of the plan
