REPORT

As part of the project plan for the Recreation Ground, street lighting on the site was identified as an asset for 'hand back'.

The council has certificates of unmetered supplies from two MPAN numbers.

As part of the process, information was sought from WLDC and LCC to identify which is their lighting on-site. This highlighted that all the street lighting from lampposts on the site is accounted for by the other public authorities.

As such, National Grid was contacted to investigate. From this, they confirmed the two mpans, have been logically disconnected (06/08/24).

They have back dated as far as their systems allow and made the change effective from the 26/06/2023.

They also have informed the council's supplier.
