

Hedgehog Operational Group

Update for Planning Committee Wednesday 16 October 2024

Background

In-line with the council's sustainability objective the council is supportive of being a 'Hedgehog Friendly Parish' in response to the declining hedgehog population, and to seek to contribute to this vital species' recovery.

Update on progress

- A councillor and two residents have worked together with COMMS to raise the profile of the declining hedgehog population.
- The library now has a wide variety of resources for residents and is a 'drop off' point for food such as cat or dog food for hedgehogs. This is taken to Wildlife Wildline Sanctuary.
- There have been a number of residents interested in supporting the campaign.
- With a generous donation to purchase hedgehog highways, these are now stocked in Poole's shop on the High Street
- COMMS- There are regular seasonal posts with information on hedgehogs.
- In response to the interest from residents wanting to help, there will be an open meeting on Wednesday 30 October 10-11am upstairs in St Andrews Community Centre, to give information and facts and encourage residents to map sightings of hedgehogs in the parish.
