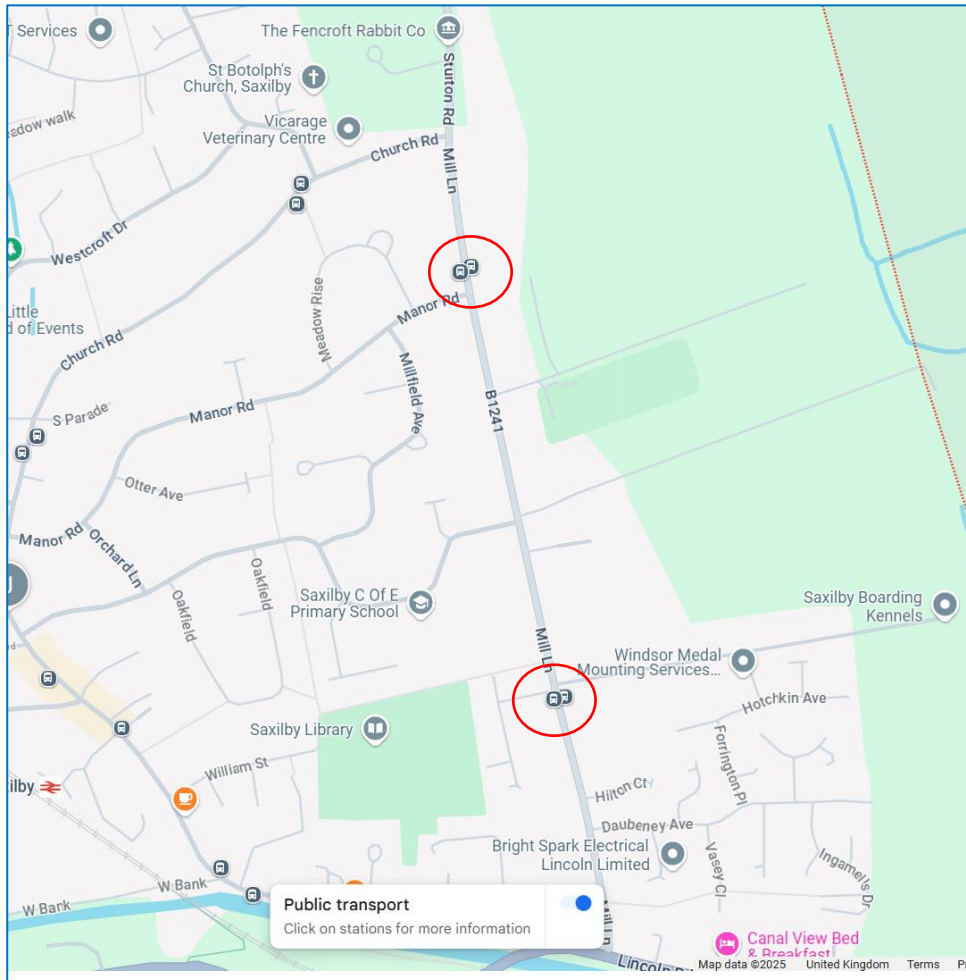
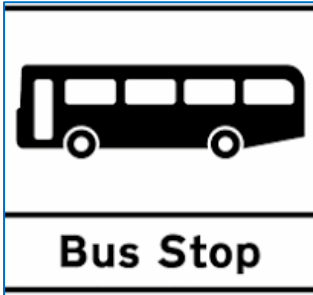

Bus Stop Locations

Currently there are no delineated bus stops on Mill Lane and residents have requested that bus stop (poles) are installed, so they know where the bus stops are located.



Existing bus stop locations

Lincolnshire County Council is proposing the following locations for bus stop poles to mark the existing (unmarked) bus stops on Mill Lane:

Mill Lane – Manor Rd Location x 2



Mill Lane - Foss Dyke Gardens x 2



They have requested:

“The Lincolnshire Road Safety Partnership have completed a safety audit of the current bus stop locations, with a view to installing a bus stop pole at each of the locations.

The recommendation is that the bus stop currently located near to the pedestrian crossing is moved further away from the crossing. Please see attached pictures of the recommended locations.

Please can you liaise with the local residents in relation to these bus stop poles and let me know if you wish to proceed.”
