

Saxilby Waterfront Working Group Update for Planning and Development Committee Wednesday 19 March 2025

- 1. **NDP 1.3** Fundraising: the Sports Hub have kindly offered to support us with a fundraising event for the Waterfront. It will take place on Friday 28 March 2025 3pm-6pm. A variety of freshly baked cakes will be for sale and hotdogs. Please come along to support this as the Regeneration of the Waterfront is a council project in the NDP and with improvements coming from grants and fund raising.
- 2. Project List 2: Conservation Leaflet: The working group have drafted a leaflet on living in a conservation area. It is bespoke to Saxilby, including a map of the conservation area. Once approved by council and WLDC Conservation Officer it be given to residents and businesses in the area. It will also go on the website and in the library. The cost of the leaflets will be minimal and will be shared verbally, with funding coming out of the Waterfront budget.
- 3. **The Waterfront Big Spring Clean**: Our volunteer days are back from Saturday 5 April starting with the Big Spring Clean. Councillors, their families and friends are also invited to come along to take part. Refreshments will be provided.
- **4. Storage Facilities:** Has been fitted out with new shelving and a stock take of current equipment has taken place.
- 5. **Volunteers 2024**. There were 175 volunteer hours last year between April and September. These numbers are submitted to CRT on a yearly basis as part of our partnership agreement.
- 6. Plaque for the memory branch (project list 6.4): It was identified that a plaque was needed to inform the public what the memory branch means. It is proposed that a stainless steel A5 plaque is ordered with the wording being provided as agenda item 16c. Funding is from the SWWG budget.
