Neighbourhood Development Plan (NDP)

The updated draft NDP has been recommended for approval by the Planning & Development Committee. Full Council will consider the Plan for approval in May.

If approved, the Plan will be submitted to West Lindsey District Council (WLDC) to continue the approval process including independent examination and a parish referendum. The Plan will form a vital basis for decisions regarding planning and development in our parish for the next fifteen years.

Sale of Alcohol at St Andrews Community Centre

Due to the resignation of our Designated Premises Supervisor (DPS), we are currently unable to sell alcohol at the Community Centre, unless a Temporary Event Notice (TEN) is in place. These can be applied for up to 15 times per year. The bar remains available for hire to serve non-alcoholic drinks (0.5% ABV or below) and snacks without a TENS.

This change is effective immediately and will remain in place until a new DPS is appointed, or alternative arrangements are put in place. The matter will be considered in May by council to agree the next steps. We thank you for continuing to support our Civility and Respect Policy during this transition period and appreciate your understanding whilst new arrangements are made.

Public Consultation: Saxilby Waterfront Public Facilities

As part of the Neighbourhood Development Plan, we are exploring the creation of a village heritage room. We are consulting on the proposal to convert the existing boater shower room (at the Waterfront) into this new space, while keeping the existing public toilet and sluice facilities.
