The reviewed NDP was approved by Full Council in May to be submitted to West Lindsey District Council. WLDC are have now publicised the plan proposal (Regulation 16 consultation), including sharing with statutory bodies for any comments. After an independent examination, a referendum date will be set.

The plan contains planning policies which will be used alongside the national and local plans to determine planning applications in the parish for the next fifteen years.
