Tree Works Across the Parish

Tree maintenance is taking place across Saxilby following an expert assessment. Work will address unsafe trees, remove non-native species, and support biodiversity with new native planting. Please take care near work areas and follow safety signs.

Objective: Maintain and improve community facilities and amenities

Several improvements are underway across our parish to enhance local facilities for residents and visitors alike.

At St Andrews Community Centre, the refurbishment of the upstairs men's toilets has now been completed, providing a fresher, more accessible space for users.

At Saxilby Waterfront Public Facilities, the doors and windows are being replaced, marking the next step in the wider refurbishment programme. Once the exterior work is complete, internal refurbishment will follow, informed by the results of the current public consultation.

Meanwhile, Saxilby AFC have been working with our grounds team to redecorate and improve the Mill Lane Changing Rooms. We're also applying for a grant to install solar panels, supporting their sustainability and long-term energy efficiency.
