

## **Action plan for Second-Hand Sale – Saturday 21<sup>st</sup> March 2026**

### **Update:**

Due to the village hall holding a craft fair at the start of February, it would be best to focus on reuse and recycle for this event. This would link it to 'Global Recycling Day' held on 18<sup>th</sup> March.

A Second-Hand Sale is all encompassing and will encourage residents to have a clear-out, make space, and raise a bit of money for themselves. This encourages positive mental health and wellbeing. This event will also help engagement and bring the community together.

Due to risk and liability, electrical items are not to be sold. Instead, residents can offer these types of items when the Yard Sales take place later in the year.

Admin will do a 'for your info' poster to put out on comms so residents know the event is coming up. A 'booking' comms post will go out later.

### **Next Steps – to decide at next Events WG meeting:**

#### **Choose Lead Councillor/s for event**

Councillor/s required to supervise over event

#### **Agree times for event**

suggest 1-5pm, with an hour before for setting up plus time after for tidying away/cleaning.

#### **Consider charging for event**

Suggest we charge table-holders a nominal fee – payable in advance to secure a table. Money raised to go to either general events, Remembrance or Christmas (might be good to be specific rather than general).

**Cake/Drinks:**

Are we going to do a cake/drinks stall to help raise extra money? We could ask for cake donations. Nominal charges for drinks/cakes.
