


# Council News

## Clothes Bank Update

The Salvation Army Trading Company has removed clothes bins at the New Burial Ground, Brackenbury Road and the Public Recreation Ground Car Park due to reduced demand for second-hand clothing, rising operational costs, and issues such as fly-tipping.

Donations can still be made at the Fire Station clothes bank, which remains in place and supports The Fire Fighters Charity.

The Parish Council Bra Bank is also still in place in St Andrews Community Centre, where unwanted bras can be donated in support of Against Breast Cancer, with over 100 bras being donated to date.
