## ST ANDREWS CENTRE LEASE

### SECURED

Great news for Saxilby! **Saxilby Public Recreation Ground Charity** and **Saxilby with Ingleby Parish Council** have signed a **25-year lease** for the St Andrews Community Centre. This ensures the parish council can continue offering vital services including the library, room and bar hire, sports changing rooms, and provide a parish office.



The lease also gives the charity stability to care for the recreation ground, safeguarding this much-loved open space for Saxilby and Hardwick residents.

This milestone completes six recreation ground leases set up over the past 18 months, covering the community centre, outdoor spaces, and sports club facilities. Thank you to all councillors, council officers, and charity trustees for working to secure our community's facilities and green spaces for the long term.
