This accessibility statement applies to the website:

Saxilby with Ingleby Parish Council is committed to ensuring digital accessibility for people with disabilities. We want as many people as possible to be able to use this website.

For example, this means you should be able to:

- change colours, contrast levels and fonts using browser or device settings
- zoom in up to 300% without the text spilling off the screen
- navigate most of the website using just a keyboard
- navigate most of the website using speech recognition software
- listen to most of the website using a screen reader (including the most recent versions of JAWS, NVDA and VoiceOver)

We have also tried to make the website text as simple as possible to understand.

The organisation AbilityNet has advice on making your device easier to use if you have a disability.

How accessible this website is

We know some parts of this website are not fully accessible.

For example:

- some older PDF documents are not fully accessible to screen reader software
- text may not reflow into a single column when you resize the browser window
- users may not be able to modify line height or spacing of text
- some pages may not allow users to skip directly to the main content
- live video streams may not have captions

We are working to improve accessibility as part of ongoing website updates.

Non-accessible content

The content listed below is not fully accessible for the following reasons.

- when increasing the font size, some items overflow and may be slightly difficult to read
- some pages are linked to external websites that are not fully accessible
- some document attachments are not clearly written
- some graphics and document attachments have poor colour contrast
- some images do not have good alternative text
- some buttons are not correctly identified
- some documents are in PDF, Excel or Word format and are not accessible
- Some documents published before 23 September 2018 may not be fully accessible to screen reader software. These documents are exempt from the accessibility regulations. However, if you need information from these documents in an accessible format, please contact us and we will provide it where possible.
- Live video streams may not have captions. This is exempt from the accessibility regulations.

What we are doing to improve accessibility

Saxilby with Ingleby Parish Council is committed to improving accessibility and usability of its website. We will:

- review and update older PDF documents where practical
- ensure new documents are accessible wherever possible
- review website accessibility periodically
- consider accessibility improvements when the website is updated
