



Saxilby with Ingleby Neighbourhood Plan Review Steering (Working) Group

Update for Planning and Development Committee Wednesday 18 March 2026

1. The Neighbourhood Development Plan (NDP) Review Working Group has considered and accepted the Independent Examiner's Report. The Working Group recommends that, subject to the incorporation of the modifications set out in the report, the review of the NDP be accepted and that the Plan proceed to referendum.
2. Preparations for the referendum, including publicity and community engagement activity, are ongoing. These arrangements will be formalised once the referendum date has been confirmed.

3. H2East Pipeline: Humber to Nottinghamshire Consultation

Planning and Development Committee is advised of the following in relation to the consultation:

- The proposed pipeline is underground
- No NDP policies apply, as recent National Infrastructure projects are not included in the Plan.
- The indicative route passes through the Hardwick Scrub Nature Project, should be given consideration in order to protect its ecological and community value.
- Public information events are being held to enable stakeholders and residents to obtain further details.
- Residents will be informed via Foss Focus and social media.

To receive an update and agree recommendation

1. Planning and Development Committee is requested to receive the update and to recommend to Full Council that the Independent Examiner's Final Report be accepted, enabling the reviewed Saxilby with Ingleby Neighbourhood Development Plan (2025–2040), incorporating the recommended minor modifications, to proceed to referendum.
