There are no recommendations for the Planning and Development Committee.

- The Events Working Group met on 9 June 2026 and reviewed progress across current community events and projects.
- Burial Ground volunteer sessions continue to be successful, although further volunteers are needed; comms continue to promote this.
- The Yard Sale currently has 19 uptakes and is also being promoted by comms.
- The May fundraiser raised £391 for Wildline Wildlife Sanctuary. The group agreed that the next fundraiser should support the Christmas lights event.
- Planning continues for Family Fun Day; councillors will prepare project display boards for the Council stall.
- The MUGA opening with picnic games event remains on hold pending completion of the MUGA.
- Menopause Awareness Day was suggested to be incorporated as part of Wellbeing Week.
- The group will continue exploring the feasibility of a Blood Bank session in Saxilby.
- The group does not currently have capacity to support the school hedging project.
