Re: Westcroft Green Space Redevelopment Update

We are pleased to provide an update on the Westcroft Green Space Redevelopment Project.

Following extensive public consultation, the parish council has agreed a redevelopment approach that reflects the feedback received from residents and users of the site. The consultation showed strong support for improving opportunities for recreation and relaxation whilst maintaining the green and natural character of the space.

To achieve this, the project will be delivered using a zoned approach, creating different areas within the green space that cater for a range of users and activities. The proposed zones include:

- **Active zones** for play and fitness activities
- **A relaxation zone** with seating, sensory planting and additional landscaping
- **An imaginative zone** designed to encourage creative and informal play

This approach will help ensure that Westcroft Green Space remains a welcoming and enjoyable area for residents of all ages.

Work now underway

The first phase of the project is focused on the relaxation zone. Plans include:

- New seating
- Sensory planting
- Additional bulb planting
- Six new native trees

These improvements will enhance the appearance of the site, support local biodiversity, and create a pleasant space for residents to enjoy.

Developing the active zones

The council has also begun working with specialist play and recreation providers to develop ideas for active zones. Initial designs are currently being explored and refined.

Once potential options have been developed, residents will have a further opportunity to view and comment on proposals before any final decisions are made.

Funding and next steps

The parish council continues to seek external funding to support the delivery of the project and maximise the improvements that can be achieved.

We will continue to provide updates as the project progresses and we look forward to sharing further information with residents in the coming months.
