The report will be shared with Lincolnshire County Council and Sustrans to help inform discussions about a trial.

# Council Meeting Updates



## Full Council (3 June)

Key decisions and updates included:

- Completing the annual review of council policies and governance documents
- Increasing the budget available to support local community groups and approving grant funding applications
- Approving new energy contracts for council facilities
- Referring consideration of overnight stays and parking arrangements at the New Burial Ground to the Planning Committee
- Beginning work on proposals to improve the entrance, stairwell and library areas at St Andrews Community Centre

Councillors received an update on the new Multi-Use Games Area (MUGA), with works progressing well and the project nearing completion.

Councillors also noted concerns raised by residents regarding highways junction visibility and parking issues within the village, which will be reported to the relevant authorities.

The next Full Council meeting will take place on Wednesday 1 July 2026 as part of the council's scheduled meeting programme.

## Planning and Development Committee (17 June)

Key decisions and updates included:

- Submitting comments on two planning applications received from West Lindsey District Council
- Reviewing local trees of community value and agreeing to continue monitoring potential candidates for future protection
- Noting a new Tree Preservation Order covering an ash tree at The Bridge Inn
- Approving a revised grass cutting schedule for selected highway verge areas
- Agreeing an interim management and use policy for the New Burial Ground car park
- Supporting further discussions with Lincolnshire County Council and Sustrans regarding a potential Quiet Lane trial in the parish

Councillors also raised concerns regarding traffic management during Lincolnshire Show diversion routes, highway visibility at the A57/Skellingthorpe Road junction, and grounds maintenance matters, with follow-up actions agreed.

The committee received updates on the Neighbourhood Development Plan, the Multi-Use Games Area (MUGA), Westcroft Green Space re-development project, community events, and plans for the 2026 Family Fun Day.

The next Planning and Development meeting will take place on Wednesday 15 July 2026 as part of the council's scheduled meeting programme.

## Finance and Risk Committee (17 June)

The scheduled meeting of the Finance and Risk Committee did not take place as the meeting was inquorate. Insufficient councillors were available to attend, with apologies received from a number of committee members.

This means the next Finance and Risk meeting will take place on Wednesday 15 July 2026 as part of the council's scheduled meeting programme.
