Saxilby Waterfront Working Group

- The black metal tree seat has been delivered, is in the workshop and will be put in place by mid March by our grounds team.
- The Conservation Volunteers (TCV) have replaced the trees along Bridge Street that did not survive the hot summer.
- The memory branch sculpture is ready and a site visit is planned for next week.
- The fund raising 'valentine' themed tombola at the Co-op store raised a fantastic £161 towards the Waterfront.
