Recommend to Full Council the proposed change of scheme for the Saxilby Waterfront Public Facilities Refurbishment to include sustainability measures including solar panels

Power/duty which decision falls under: Public Health Act 1936 s87- A parish council may provide sanitary conveniences.

Which council objective(s) it falls under:

1. Maintain and improve community facilities and amenities
2. Protect and enhance our green spaces and street scene
3. Preserve and enhance heritage assets, environmental assets and wildlife
4. Retain and encourage employment and tourism opportunities
5. Improve the well-being of residents
8. To recognise the climate and biodiversity emergency and it should be considered as the basis of all decision and policy making

Consideration on carbon reduction: The refurbishment will significantly reduce the carbon footprint of the facility and contribute to a reduced parish carbon footprint. The change in carbon footprint will be calculated as part of the scheme.

Public Sector Equality Duty (*Consider or think about how policies or decisions affect people who are protected under the Equality Act*) The facility will be in-line with the public sector equality duty.

A priority council project is the refurbishment of Saxilby Waterfront Public Facilities. This project has been sometime in development and the council's objectives have changed to include considering the climate emergency as part of the decision-making process.

Consequently, the project now seeks to include additional sustainability measures within its scope.
