Update on the LCC cycle path connection between Lincoln and Saxilby (NDP project 1.4)

Consideration on carbon reduction:

Providing a connection would increase access to sustainable forms of travel connecting Saxilby to Lincoln. It provides the opportunity to reduce the number of car journeys to and from the parish.

Consideration of risk management in relation to proposal:

- The project is a county council project, which was re-initiated due to its inclusion in the Neighbourhood Development Plan (NDP).
- Potential impact on public engagement and reputation if the project does not come into fruition, having been identified by the community as an important project.

REPORT:

November 2023

It is understood the legal agreement has now been signed by parties whose land the cycle track is crossing. Lincolnshire County Council are chasing the return of the agreement from the solicitors of one of the land owners. This has also been chased the clerk.

With regards to the construction of the footway/cycleway it is programmed in for April/May 2024 and will be delivered by Lincolnshire County Council Term Contractor – Balfour Beatty.

Some hedging adjacent to the A57 near the cycle track access will need to be removed and it is likely this will be carried out earlier to ensure it is before the bird nesting season. The timing of the works will be shared over the next month or so.



Background


The Saxilby with Ingleby NDP project to complete the cycle track connection from Lincoln to Saxilby from the A57 through the Daubeney estate and Sellars Walk is an NDP project to improve connectivity in the area.

The county council confirmed back in 2019/20 that the project would be progressing and would be completed in that financial year.

Lobbying from the parish council has ensured the project has continued to date and the investment has not been lost from the area.
